A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIFLE,
COLORADO, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN
ENERGY AND MINERAL IMPACT ASSISTANCE FUND GRANT
APPLICATION FOR THE 12th STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Rifle has finalized planning and design documents for the pedestrian corridor along 12th Street and Howard Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rifle desires to construct a safe pedestrian corridor along 12th Street that includes construction of approximately 1,500 linear feet of new sidewalk, curb, and gutter; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for a grant from the Department of Local Affairs Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Fund in the amount of \$75,000 to complete the 12th Street Sidewalk Project and the City is willing to commit a local match of \$75,000 available in the City's general fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Rifle, Colorado, that:

1. The City incorporates the foregoing recitals as findings by the City Council.
2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit an Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Fund Grant Application to complete the 12th Street Sidewalk Project.
3. If a grant is awarded, the City of Rifle hereby authorizes the Mayor to sign an Energy and Mineral Impact Assistance Fund Grant Agreement with the Colorado Department of Local Affairs. The City of Rifle will continue to maintain the improvements in a high quality condition and will appropriate funds for maintenance.

THIS RESOLUTION was read, passed, and adopted by the Rifle City Council at a regular meeting held this 18th day of March, 2015.
