

## HOW DOES THE TIERED RATE WORK AND SEWER AVERAGING

Please note that the bill you receive each month is for services the prior month ( Jan services bill Feb 1<sup>st</sup>).

**EXAMPLE:** 26,000 gallons (last winter's Average household water usage 4,000 gal)

### October Water

**EXAMPLE:** 26,000 gallons (sewer based on actual household usage)

Sewer 5,000 gal. (Nov – Mar)

Sewer 0 - 4,000 gal. (Nov – March)

Summer Sewer Charges are based on Average winter household usage. You will never pay less than the base. If water usage is lower than the average sewer charge you will pay the lesser amount.

If in 5 months (Nov – Mar) a total of 24,000 gallons were used the calculated sewer average would be 4,800 gallons (24÷5=4,800).

In Summer if you only used only 4,000 or less you will pay the base charge (Apr – Oct). If you used 26,000 gallons in a single month you would pay for 4,800 gallons of sewer.
